 Opened in December 2009, Parks of Lewisville Railroad Park was developed as a new place and is the largest single capital project in the history of Lewisville. The sprawling park features soccer fields, a dog park, a water park, three lakes for recreation, and a 1.5 mile pedestrian walking/jogging trail designed to connect to the regional Fossil Park.

The original Fossil Park (opened 1997) was built south of the park and its historic track. Just west of the park area across the Texas County Transportation Authority's A Tron. The intent of the park was to take advantage of the deep water of the local rail service, which is important to the community that controls the state of the original Fossil Park.
